Transition from Reception to Year 1

Our aim is to ensure that the children experience a smooth transition from the Foundation Stage to Key Stage One. The Year 1 curriculum builds upon and extends the experiences that children have had in Reception. I can already see the children being excellent role models for the Reception children in our class and they have been very kind and friendly to them.

Reading in Year 1

Your child will be bringing home a reading book in the next couple of weeks. This should be brought in each day. We will read with each child individually during the week. Please try to read with your child every night and sign the planner. Later Phonics and Spelling homework will help to consolidate their learning.

Autumn term areas of study

English - We shall look at the book 'Dear Zoo' and other animal books both fiction and non-fiction. Later we will read Superhero books and of course some Christmas texts.

Maths - Place Value (Counting within 10 moving onto 20, one more/one less, addition/subtraction within 10/20 and shape).

Topic/Science We shall be studying Humans and other animals and then the Great Fire of London. We shall also look at Harvest, Bonfire Night and Remembrance Day.

RE- What does it mean to be a Christian and the Christmas Story.

PE/Music - with coaches for dance and music. Fundamental movement skills.

General Reminders...

- Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school and that all items are NAMED. We encourage children to practise getting dressed at home to help them get changed quickly in school!
 NAMED uniform also helps us during this time.
