

Hello,

My name is Rev'd Cait Walker. I am the new vicar at 5t Michael's Church, Mottram, Broadbottom and Hattersley East. Every year our church has a Christingle service, which regularly sees around 400 people attend. The collection for this service goes to the Children's Society.

Unfortunately, due to Covid restrictions, we will not be able to meet in such large numbers, but we would like to enable people to engage with the church's Christmas celebrations and to raise money and awareness for the charity.

We will be sending out packs with information and materials for people to make their own Christingle and to help them to collect money. We also wanted something that people could engage with in their own time (so not to encourage large crowds). We are looking to produce a Living Community Advent Calendar and would like to invite you to create one of the windows.

You will be given a number (date in December) and a theme for your window. Then, on that day you can unveil your window design - this can be painted on the glass, a collage or a collection of items and will display your number. This display then needs to be visible until the end of December. The packs that we give out will contain a map of all the windows so that people can visit them at their leisure.
