Dear Parents,

We appreciate that this is a challenging time for families. The timetable has been adjusted to enable peers to be dropped off at school.

If you are unable to access the assembly, do not worry. Please try to access as many of the lessons as you can during the day, to keep an educational momentum going with your child. The class teacher will be online, at all times, during the day, except lunch, and children can ask questions via the hands up button on the chat function. The children have had lots of practice of this during the week.

On Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January, there will be a live chat link on your main class page, which will appear at the top near the class name on the banner. This link enables your child to enter the live lessons. This feature is similar to zoom, where you initially enter a waiting room and the host (Class Teacher) will let the children in at 9:30. This will close down over the lunchtime period and children will need to re-enter at 1pm.

When your child is completing their independent work, you can direct them to their teacher for advice via the hands up button and chat facility. If you need to speak to the class teacher, at any point, do this via ClassDojo, which offers you a private connection.

The registration code for children that week, will not affect their overall attendance at school.

Please note, if works are completed sooner than the given timescale, normal classroom arrangements will commence, and we will be in contact with you about this.
