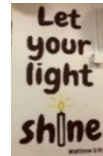

For £1 they can wear Christmas jumpers and Christmas hats with their school trousers or dress.

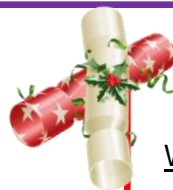
