Dear Parents,

Partial Closure of School for Red Class

On Monday 7th December 2020, I met with a team of specialist contractors, with regards to a Defect Analysis Report concerning the ceiling, and roof space, in the main school building. Following a previous inspection, significant defects have been identified, that require immediate repair to the suspended ceiling and needs all internal tiles to be removed, plus internal boards to be installed.

As such, I am writing to inform you that works are required to be carried out immediately, as instructed by the Local Authority. This will commence on Saturday 19th of December 2020, with completion on Friday 8th of January 2021. This will mean that children in Red Class, will not be able to return to school until Monday 11th of January 2021. During this week, a blended learning package will be provided, via Google Classroom, from the single-bubble timetable, which is attached to ensure that education commences on time.

All information on how to access Google classrooms is available on the school website, if you experience any problems. In addition, you will be able to communicate with your child's teacher on ClassDojo. The children will have all practised how to access the live lessons they will be required to attend during each day. Registration will take place at 9am daily with breaks and lunches similar to a normal school day.

Best efforts have been made, by all the contractors concerned, to work throughout the Christmas period, to ensure least disruption. I apologise that this will unfortunately overspill into the new term, but I am duty bound to follow the recommendations within the report.

The remainder of school will be open if you do need to contact us.
