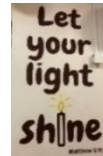

If one of our pupils becomes unwell and has a positive test result for Covid-19, the DFE and local authority have asked parents if they will report this to school. This applies to the 6 days following the last contact with school.

Therefore, if this situation applies to your child between breaking up on the 18th December to 24th December, please email the following address to report a confirmed case to:

Below is the only information you will need to provide:

- When symptoms started, or the date of the test if asymptomatic
- The test date
- When the child was last in school

The school office will be closed, therefore, it is important that you use the above email and do not leave a message on the answer phone.
