Free Easter Event

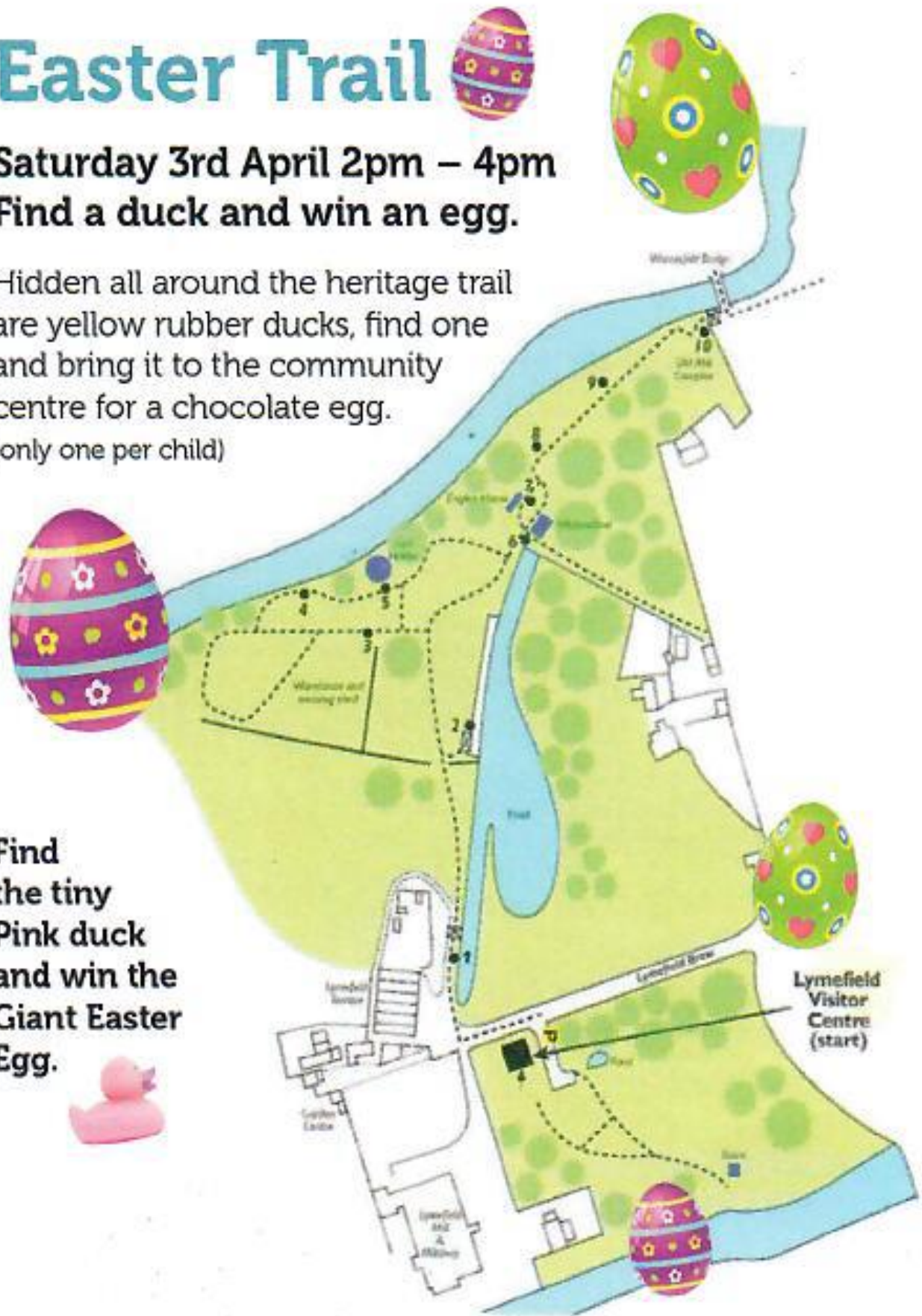
Wander around Lymefield's trail looking for the yellow ducks and one pink duck to claim your chocolate prize, (one duck per child).
