Reading



- Reading is at the heart of everything at Broadbottom and a partnership between home and school.
- When your child begins to read, they will come home with a reading book and a reading record.
- For Reception children the expectation is that they read for 5 minutes each night or over the week 30 minutes.
- More information will be provided about reading and phonics in September.



Absence, Lates & Holiday Requests



- Please contact the office to report an absence BEFORE 9.30 am.
 Otherwise you will receive a phone call / text message enquiring
 where your child is. (This needs to be done daily on subsequent
 absences.)
- Pupils who have sickness or diarrhoea need to be kept off school for 48 hours commencing from the last bout of sickness and diarrhoea.
- If you arrive late, you must accompany your child to the school office and sign them in.
- Holidays in term time will be unauthorised in accordance with legislation from the Department of Education. (Please see the letter in your information pack.)
- Attendance is key to achieving and making progress and is closely monitored by Tameside Education Welfare. Please make sure your child attends and is punctual to school everyday, unless poorly.



Hints and Tips



The following suggestions help your child to settle.

- Velcro shoes no laces.
- Easy to put on pumps.
- Trousers that boys can manage.
- Practice putting on coats and zipping if possible.
- Practice dressing and undressing.
- Extra under wear/socks in case of accidents.
- Something to help distinguish pump bags /book bags e.g. key rings.
- A tag to hang coats up if there isn't one already in your child's coat.

Please do not send big bags containing PE kits due to restricted space.
