Learning a language provides an opening to other cultures. It should develop curiosity and deepen understanding of the world around them. At Broadbottom, our vision is to allow children opportunity to let their light shine. Learning a language provides this opportunity.

At the end of Key Stage Two, children should be confident in discussing German culture and conversing in the German language. By following a sequential plan, topics will be introduced, and revisited, from year 4 upwards.

At Broadbottom, we provide a minimum of 30minutes of Mfl teaching per week. We chose German as our chosen language as Longendale has longstanding links with Ruppichterath. This German town is located in the Rhine valley between Cologne and Bonn.

Spoken German is our focus, with written work being developed as they move through the school.

Resources for teaching are mainly taken from the Goethe Institute and zeitfuerdeutsche.com but others are used where suitable.
