
#### **Vodaphone Digital Safety Magazine**

At this time of year, we always contribute to a foodbank or homeless shelter and ask that pupils bring a small donation of dried or canned food.






# Don't miss out...

# ...on a school place for your child



#### If your child will be 4 before 1 September 2023

- · You should put your child's name down at any Tameside Primary School.
- During October the school will send you the information you will need to make your application.
- If your child attends a school nursery this will not secure them a place in Reception. You will need to make a new application for a Reception place.
- You must apply for a Primary School Reception place online through the Tameside Council website at <u>www.tameside.gov.uk</u>
- The online application facility will open for new Reception applications early November 2022.
- The closing date for Primary School applications is 15 January 2023.
- Any application received after 15 January 2023 will be dealt with as a 'LATE' application and considered after those received on time.



#### If your child will be 11 before 1 September 2023

- · You should apply for a High School place through the local authority where you live.
- · Extra district residents will receive information on how to apply from their own local authority.
- · You must apply for a High School Year 7 place online through the Tameside Council website at <a href="www.tameside.gov.uk">www.tameside.gov.uk</a>
- The online application facility will open for new Year 7 applications early September 2022.
- · The closing date for High School applications is 31 October 2022.
- Any application received after 31 October 2022 will be dealt with as a 'LATE' application and considered after those received on time.
