Dear Parents,

I am delighted to inform you that following the success of last term's course we are expanding the soccer coaching programme for 2025. The new course will start on **Monday 8th September** and runs for 14 weeks.

The courses are run by **F.A. Qualified** coaches and are open to **boys and girls** aged between 4 and 13. All abilities are catered for with total beginners introduced through **fun** and confidence building practices. The course is tightly structured to ensure all aspects of football skills are developed. Coaches are DBS checked.

The course will be held **Indoors** so suitable sportswear should be worn and please bring a non-fizzy drink.


The cost of the course is £7 a week which is **payable every 4 weeks** (£28) with the first payment due on week one (second payment due on week 5 and so on). **Half price** for second and subsequent brothers and sisters, again payable every four weeks (£14). The club is fully supervised so children may be left in our care, however parents are welcome to stay and watch if they wish to.


