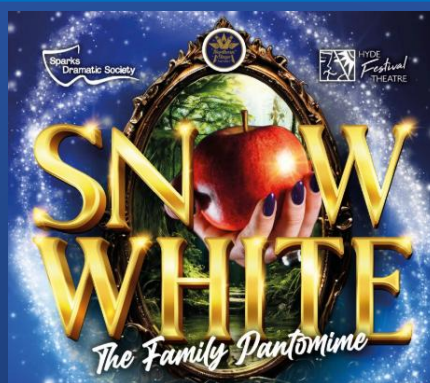

Over the years we've created plays, musicals (including *Annie*, *Oliver!* and *Hairspray*) and created short films (featuring *zombies*, *aliens* and *superheroes!*) and we have big plans for 2026!
