Encourage our pupils to be expressive and imaginative.


Stretch young minds beyond the boundaries of printed text and fact.

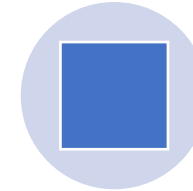
